From the late 1950's to the early 1990's an estimated 1000 Terrace Park residents and friends were part of the Terrace Park Players, an incredibly talented community theater group.

At its peak, the group produced two plays, a musical, a pops concert, an occasional children's production and a very entertaining supper show each year.

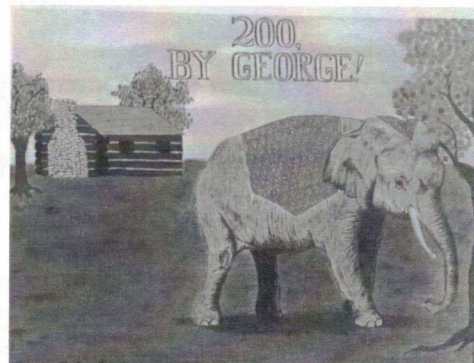
Venues included the Terrace Park School, the Community House, the Log Cabin, the Village Green, occasionally the schools of Mariemont and at least once, the Old School House restaurant in Camp Denison.

Sadly, many of the stars of our community stage have left us, but please pass this message along to anyone you may know who was part of the Players. Our archives include a treasure trove of photos, original music and programs and we are hoping to share this with the community.

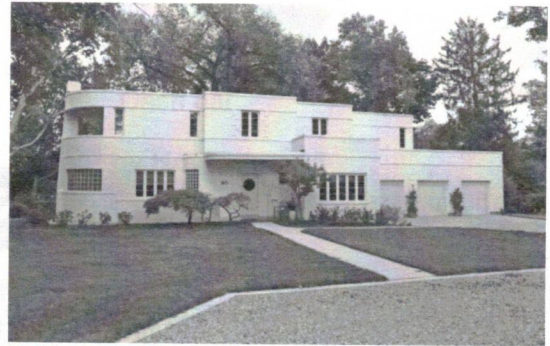
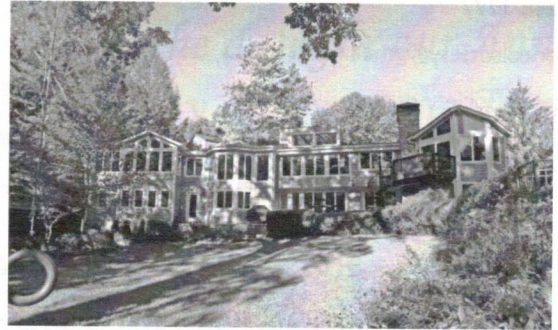
